Monarch Park Barrier-Free Pathway Installation

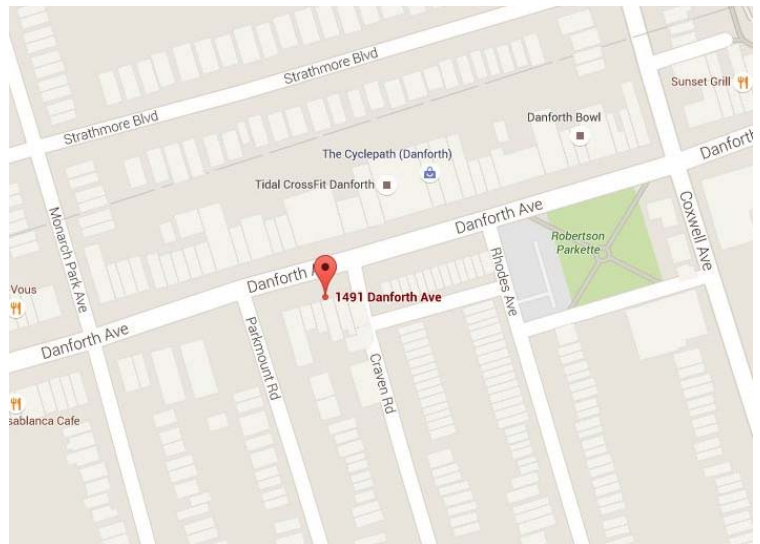
Public Information Meeting
